Event Recap: Xenia Marathon

The Xenia Marathon was held on Sunday, April 2. The day started out fairly chilly, but it warmed up just enough that conditions were excellent for the runners. An estimated 725 runners started the race. Some ran 10K, some ran the half marathon, and some ran the full marathon.

We started the day with 21 ham volunteers. A number of the hams moved to a second assignment after the last runner passed their location and we were able to cover the course very well with limited resources. We had not been asked to provide coverage of the 10 K and this was the source of some confusion as the 10 K course followed a portion of the marathon course and the 10 K runners arrived at some of the covered locations before the volunteers expected to see runners. Perhaps we can integrate 10 K coverage into our plan, next time.

There were relatively few problems among the runners. A notable exception is that one of the last half dozen runners collapsed just after crossing the finish line. The medics were sitting in their truck just across the street and saw the whole thing, so response time was very short.

Fortunately, the runner recovered quickly and only needed to be given first aid for the abrasions that resulted from the fall.

Thanks to all of the volunteers who came out and helped to support this event. A special thanks to Eric and Sami who swept the course on their bicycles.
