A quick reminder when reporting severe weather to a net or to Skywarn to report only the information they are looking for:

Report the size of the largest hailstone. Wind Damage (structural damage or trees/power lines down) Stream flooding, street flooding, or streams approaching bank full.

Do not report lightning, thunder or rain.
